### DAAD history:

"It all began with Carl Joachim Friedrich, a university student in Heidelberg, Germany. After returning from a study tour to the US in 1922, he secured thirteen additional scholarships for his fellow students through the US-based Institute of International Education (IIE). This lay the foundation for the Academic Exchange Service, a precursor to the DAAD, which was officially founded on 1 January 1925" (bottom: <https://www.daad.de/der-daad/ueber-den-daad/portrait/en/32996-from-the-very-beginning/>).

## German Chancellor Fellowship

Send an application, if you ... a) are a university graduate with an international bias from Brazil, China, India, Russia or the USA and have already acquired initial leadership experience b) work in a sector such as politics, economics, the media, administration and culture c) would be interested in spending a year working on a project you have developed yourself with a host of your choice in Germany.

Submit your **application by 15 September**. The fellowship begins on 1 October of the following year. Next application round is scheduled to **begin on 15 March 2018**.
